A summary of the meeting held at Rosley Hall on Monday 9th February 2015. Councillor D Fairbairn attended.

1. Community policing – there have been eight incidents reported including the theft of logs, diesel and farm equipment, particularly quad bikes. The police can provide farmers and other quad bike owners with smart water kits at a discounted price of £45. Contact AllerdaleRuralNPT@cumbria.police.uk or call 101. **2. Footway lighting** – there is still a lot of discussion between Electricity North West and Allerdale Borough Council to try and resolve the problem of replacing footway lighting when it is removed from telegraph poles. The lights at Rosley Hall and Church are to be removed but no date has been set as yet. The lights at Curthwaite, Top Rosley and Westward could also be affected at a later date. **3. Super Fast Broadband** – when questioned by Cllr Fairbairn, while visiting Dalston, Grant Schapps MP confirmed that Westward is part of the last 5% of the country which will **not** get super fast broadband. **4. Finance:** – the following donations were agreed - Rosley Hall and Westward Halls £800 each, Rosley and Westward Churchyards £250 each, Northern Fells Group £400, Parish Newsletters £224, Great North Air Ambulance £400. **5. Planning** – it was agreed to support Sebergham Parish Council by objecting to the erection of a wind turbine 48.9m to hub 74m to tip at Roundhill Farm Welton. **6.** it was agreed that no work should be done on the parish land at Sandy Brow. **7. Parish Councillor Vacancy** – Mrs Tonia Rothery has been co-opted onto the council to fill an existing vacancy. Fraser Shaw has indicated that he will stand down as a councillor in May. **8. Parish Council elections** take place on 7th May. Anyone who wishes to stand for election can obtain nomination papers from the clerk or Allerdale Borough Council. Nomination papers must be submitted by 4pm on 4th April. **9.** a review of the **registration of Parish Land** is to be discussed at the next meeting. **10.** Permission was given for hedgerow maintenance to be carried out on parish land at Tracentree. **11.** To be reported to **Highways** – the street light at Westward is not working, potholes - near Jenkin Cross, at the Red Dial junction, on the Reathwaite road and the Warble Bank to Westward road, bridge damaged near Thackthwaite Hall, bridge damaged on the Intack to Raise Lodge road, a depression on the B5305 at the Reathwaite junction. This is just a brief summary of the meeting, the full minutes are available from the clerk. **The next meeting is on Monday 18th May 7.30pm at Westward Halls**

Carwath Wind Farm The planning application for the proposed wind farm was considered by the Allerdale Borough Council Development Panel on Tuesday, 10 February 2015. Six local residents spoke at the meeting as objectors, and they were supported by Duncan Fairbairn as our local Councillor. The Allerdale Planning Officers recommended that the application should be refused for a number of reasons and the 12 Councillor members of the Panel quickly came to a unanimous decision in line with the officers' recommendation. Also considered at the meeting on 10th February was the application for one wind turbine hub height 15.43m, 21.97m to tip at Clea Green, Westward, this was approved.
