A summary of the meeting held at Rosley Hall on Monday 13th August.  
Cllr. D Fairbairn attended.

**1. Matters arising** - water on the road at Red Dial:- Cllr. Fairbairn has spoken to Connect and they are to visit the site to look at the problem. Water on the road at Brocklebank:- a site visit is to be arranged so that landowners can discuss the problem with Highways. **2.** Richard Horton from TGC Renewables answered questions about the proposal for a single wind turbine, height 30m to hub, at Cleamire. **3.** an update was read out on the application for two wind turbines at Ling Lane. **4.** the Chairman thanked everyone concerned with making the celebrations over the Jubilee weekend such a success. **5.** a donation of £208 was made to fund the parish newsletters. **6.** the boundaries of parish land at Speet Gill need to be more clearly defined **7. Highways** issues raised - **a.** concerns about the number of advertising signs at Woodcock **b.** the slow signs at Red Dial need new mechanisms, when money is available **c.** the roads at Church Hill and Beckbottom are in a very bad state of repair **d.** gullies at Top Rosley and on Brocklebank need cleaning out **e.** the Highways Steward has not been in the area for some time **f.** repairs have been carried out on the Reathwaite road
