1. Mr D Stuart campaign controller of the Waver, Wiza and Wampool Waterways Group explained the background leading to the formation of the group. There is a Public Consultation Document on creating an Internal Drainage Board (IDB) in this area which can be viewed at <https://consult.environment-agency.gov.uk/portal/ho/flood/new/idbs> comments must be received by 19th December. 2. The Queen's Diamond Jubilee celebration:- a bonfire is to be lit at Hazel Springs on 4th June as part of the National String of Beacons plus a short fireworks display. Also a meeting to be held in Rosley Hall on 28th November to organise a programme of events suitable for all ages, details D Smith 016973 42546 3. Northern Fells Broadband www.northernfellsbroadband.co.uk - Mr J Stanyer explained that as a pilot project an outline application for funding has already been submitted but this has to be followed by a detailed cost breakdown and business plan to be submitted by 31st December, this will cost up to £5000 to put together. All seven parish councils are being asked for support and other funding is also being sourced.
