#### Refuse and recycling collections are set to change in the Cumberland area

Following a public consultation and comprehensive review of the current arrangements, Cumberland Council will soon introduce the

Garden waste collections - From week commencing Monday 31st March 2025 all householders with garden waste bins will continue to have one bin collected every fortnight (March - November).

There will be a yearly charge of £40 per additional bin that residents request to be collected. This is consistent with the approach in the former Copeland area. Residents will be able to make a payment for extra bins from week commencing 10 March.

Collections are fortnightly between March and November each year. Waste collections: former Allerdale area - Collections will be the same as the Carlisle and Copeland areas. Waste collections will be fortnightly from May 2025. Cardboard/paper collections will increase from monthly to fortnightly from September 2025.

Householders will be given the opportunity to request a free replacement 180 litre bin (most residents have a 120-litre bin). Requests can be made from April. For more details go to
