A summary of the meeting held at Rosley Hall on 18th November 2019.

County Councillor Mike Johnson and Allerdale Borough Councillor Mr Tony Annison attended.

- 1. Councillors reports** : - Fly Tipping – fly tipping which is on the verge, road or public footpath is the responsibility of Allerdale Borough Council, fly tipping on private land is the responsibility of the landowner. Flooding - if the water is coming off the road Highways are responsible, if the flooding is coming off the land onto the road then the landowner is responsible. Street lighting: - from 2020 the County Council will retain ownership and maintenance of street lighting, Parish Councils will be charged for energy costs only. Highways: a meeting has been arranged with Matt Bish of Cumbria Highways on 28th November to go round the parish highlighting areas of particular concern.
- 2.** Rosley Play Area – the Village Hall committee has arranged for an inspection to be carried. **3.** Parish Wood - the work to replace the walkways has been delayed due to the bad weather but will be carried out as soon as possible.
- 4.** Precept 2020/21 - this was set at £8000 and takes into account the extra expense for the cost of energy for street lighting. Please note this is just a brief summary of the meeting, the full minutes are available from the clerk.

The next Parish Council Meeting is on Monday 17th February at 7.30pm in Rosley Hall

Members of the public are welcome at all meetings. If you would like any issues raised at this meeting please contact the clerk at least two weeks beforehand so that items can be included on the agenda.
