A summary of the meeting held on Monday 22nd November at Rosley Hall.

Noticeboards: all three noticeboards in the parish are in need of refurbishment. Men in Sheds are to be contacted to ask if they could carry out the work. **Defibrillators:** there are three defibrillators in the parish at Westward Halls, Rosley Hall and in the old phone box in Curthwaite. The parish council will contribute £150 each towards maintenance in 2022, this is to be reviewed yearly. **Precept 2022/2023:** the precept was set at £8500. **The Queen's Platinum Jubilee:** a beacon is to be lit at Hazel Springs, Brocklebank, more details later. As part of the celebrations the council is also looking into suitable sites to plant a tree. **Broadband:** Connecting Cumbria have reported that many areas of the county now have good broadband connections. The clerk is to contact them to highlight that the majority Westward/Rosley parish still has very poor connections. Please note this is just a brief summary of the meeting, the full minutes are available from the clerk or on the website. **The next meeting will be in February.** Members of the public are welcome at all meetings. Solway Red Squirrel Group - Red Squirrel Stronghold, Westward

(Funded by a grant from The Lake District Foundation)

Would you like to have red squirrels visiting your garden? Our volunteers are working hard to support the small population of red squirrels in Westward, by putting up feeders and reducing the competition for food from grey squirrels. If red squirrels are in good condition in the spring then they are more likely to have a good breeding season, increasing numbers and enabling dispersal to other areas. While food shortages over winter are a threat to red squirrel survival, particularly of the young, the main threat is still squirrel pox. It only takes one grey squirrel carrying the pox to come into contact with a red and our small population could be devastated. Squirrel pox is fatal to reds and they suffer a slow lingering death. Some people say they like to see grey squirrels at their bird feeders, please remember grey squirrels raid birds nests and take eggs and nestlings. A red squirrel really is a joy to watch. Please help our local red squirrels thrive and survive by reporting any squirrel sightings, red or grey. Unsure if it's a grey? - whatever the colour of their coat grey squirrels always have a distinctive white fringe around the tail, this never occurs with red squirrels.
