A summary of the meeting held on Monday 21st November at Rosley Hall.

Please note this is just a brief summary of the meeting, the full minutes are available from the clerk. County Councillor Mike Johnson attended. **1.** A member of the public raised concerns about the effect of **Ash Dieback** on the landscape and nature and asked if any Council had a policy on how to manage trees affected and replanting. Mr Johnson was not aware of any specific policy but will make enquiries. Members of the Parish Council said that local landowners were replanting trees and some ash trees were showing early signs of recovery. **2. Finance** – the budget for 2023/2024 was discussed and the precept is unaltered at £8500. The clerks wages are to be reviewed. **3. Parish Council Website** – the website is currently being updated. Please contact the clerk if you require any information. **4.** The bus shelter at Red Dial is in poor condition, the clerk is to make enquiries as to who is responsible for its upkeep. **5.** The Village Hall committee reported that the **Playground Equipment** had been inspected and any faults found had been rectified.

The next meeting will be the on Monday 20th February 2023 7.00pm at Rosley Village Hall.
