A summary of the meeting held at Rosley Hall on Monday 20th November 2023. Councillor Mike Johnson attended.

**The Budget** for 2024-25 was discussed and the precept set at £9,000. **Westward Defibrillator:** since the fire at the Halls earlier in the year the defibrillator has been out of use. As this is unsatisfactory, and thanks to a kind offer by a nearby resident, it is to be re-sited to the outside wall of the garage at 2 Church Hill, Westward. **Broadband:** Councillor Johnson explained that the rollout in our area was progressing slower than anticipated due to the way the contracts had originally been awarded and he was to raise the matter at a meeting to be held the following day. **Westward Car Park:** the clerk is to look into the ownership of the car park, who is responsible for its upkeep and whether it should be registered as Parish land. **Highways:** some of the main challenges on the roads throughout the parish are caused by standing water which in turn leads to potholes. Councillor Johnson is to once again take this up with Highways to ask if improvements can be made to drainage to alleviate this. Flooding at Red Dial is a particular recurring problem. The clerk has reported to Highways that some HGV's are regularly using the Carlisle Bridge to Tarrangower road which has restricted access.
