A summary of the Meeting held at Rosley Hall on Monday 18th November. Councillor Mike Johnson attended. Highways: Councillor Johnson has raised the serious problem of drainage and surface water on our roads with the department but explained that because of budget restrictions and the hierarchy of roads it was a challenge for them to commit to particular projects. He also stressed how important it was for as many people as possible to report and keep reporting any defect identified as the more reports received the more likely it is to be seen to. In the case of potholes if there is more than one on a stretch of road ALL of them must be identified and reported otherwise they will not all be repaired. It is also very helpful, if possible, to send in a photo. Finance: the budget for 2025/26 was set and the precept was raised by 10% to cover the cost of all the support to be given to local organisations.
