## Defibrillator, Curthwaite

An application for a defibrillator to be installed in the phone box at Curthwaite has been submitted to the Community Heartbeat Trust and it is hoped it will be in place by the summer. This would be a community asset which we hope never to have to use but would be in place in case of need. The next nearest defibrillators are at Thursby and Rosley Hall. The cost is £1880, and an initial payment of £1150 has been paid but over £700 still needs to be raised. Grant funding is being looked into but there will probably still be a need for some local fundraising. Once installed the running costs are £135 per annum.
