You do not need special training to drive the vehicle as it is only an eight seater so is a People Carrier rather than an actual Minibus. You drive it on your normal driving licence, Category B. If you are interested, we will organise a DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) check for you and ask for two references. Once they are done and approved, we will organise a training session regarding how the service works, its records, and familiarisation with driving the minibus and operating the wheelchair winch and fixings.
