As there were ten vacancies and ten nominations there was no need for a Parish Council Election to be held at the beginning of May. **Parish Councillors for Westward** (which includes Rosley and Curthwaite) - Mr S Brockbank, Mr W Brown, Mr J Hartley, Mr E Holliday, Mrs E Osborne, Mrs J Robinson, Mrs T Rothery, Mrs B Stoddart, Mr R Studholme and Mr T Todd. A summary of the Annual Meeting held at Westward Halls on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May Mr W Brown was re-elected as Chairman, Mr T Todd as Vice Chairman. The Chairman welcomed the new clerk, Mrs Julia Webster to the meeting, also **Mr Tony Annison, Allerdale Borough Councillor for Warnell Ward** which includes Westward. Mr Annison is to report complaints about the very slow answering times of the police non-emergency number 101. He also explained why there had been so many problems with the new waste collection service and that these are being dealt with. The clerk is to follow up on the following ongoing problems **a.** flooding at Red Dial crossroads, **b.** flooding due to the blocked culvert in the dip at Brackenthwaite **c.** the two collapsed drains/manholes on the road from Rosley crossroads to East Woodside **d.** the damaged signpost at junction of the B5305 and the road to Caldbeck. She will also report fly tipping on the Reathwaite road near the junction with the B5305 and numerous potholes throughout the parish. Items to be raised at the next meeting – a request for funds from Westward Halls towards the cost of renovations and the repair/replacement of the walkway in the parish wood near Rosley School.
