## Solway Red Squirrel Group

Once again I'm asking you to **please** report any squirrel sightings, red or grey. A recent case of squirrel pox in one of our woodlands shows just how vulnerable our small population of red squirrels are. The reds had only very recently returned to this woodland in Westward and now their recovery is threatened by the presence of the greys which carry the pox virus.
