A summary of the Annual General Meeting held at Rosley Hall on Tuesday 21st May.

Cllr Brockbank thanked everyone for their time and efforts on Parish Council and said it was important that we continue to support local organisations by ways of donations as a lot of the organisations we donate to rely heavily on donations. The King's portrait has been put up in Rosley Village Hall next to the late Queen's portrait. **Westward Halls** - A meeting was held to discuss the future of the Mission Room at Westward Village Hall and it has been proposed and agreed that the mission room will be demolished and the Parish Rooms will be extended - a merger of the 2 halls. The Westward annual litter pick in April went well. **Highways** - the Chairman urged everyone to keep reporting potholes. Pot holes and drainage continue to be a problem - please report all defects through the Cumberland Highways online service. Although not moving very fast, some repairs have been carried out and repairs have been visible in the local area in recent weeks. The Chair has received a request to ask Highways to repair the verge outside Rosley Church - Highways are unable to carry out requested repairs but have placed cones in the affected area. The Parish Council are hoping to arrange for the area to be tidied up. A donation to the Rosley Link and Westward Newsletters of £200 was agreed as printing costs have recently increased. Please note this is just a brief summary of the meeting, the full minutes are available from the clerk or are published on the website. **The next meeting is Monday 19th August at 7pm in Rosley Hall**

**Rosley Hall** The hall committee have decided to increase hire charges for the first time in many years. As of 1/9/24, the cost of using the Millennium Room will be £6/hr and the Main hall, £12/hr. These charges are still very reasonable and much lower than most nearby halls. Our hall is a great community resource and it's running relies on a very small group of volunteers. To help us keep costs down we would like to remind our regular users to please vacuum/ sweep/ clean up after themselves when using the hall. By doing this we can avoid paying professional cleaning costs.

The next hall committee meeting will be Wednesday 3/7/24 at 7.30. All welcome.
