A summary of the Annual General Meeting held at Rosley Hall on Monday 19th May.

Election of Officers Stephen Brockbank was re-elected as Chairman and Thomas Todd as Vice-Chairman Councillor Mike Johnson attended.

The Chairman thanked everyone on the Parish Council and the Clerk for all their hard work over the previous year. The council works to benefit the community in many ways particularly by supporting many local organisations and charities - the Halls, newsletters, defibrillators, The Northern Fells Group and others. It was regrettable, but sensible, that the V.E. Celebrations had to be cancelled because of the fire risk caused by the continuing dry weather.

Highways: Councillor Johnson reported – the Highways department is under resourced at all levels. With the cancellation of the HS2 programme to Manchester money had been promised to Councils for highways but as this decision has now been reviewed the money has been withdrawn. As a consequence the Highways department cannot carry out much of the work planned. He also stressed again how important it is for as many people as possible to report and keep reporting any defects to prioritise a problem.

The weight limit sign at Craggs road end is still missing and many more articulated vehicles are using the road...

#### Westward Mission Room (MR) & Parish Room - progress

Following the fire in the halls it was agreed by the two committees (Parish Room committee & PCC) that they would see if the Diocese would hand over the Mission Room and then they could merge the two charities (committees) and run the halls as one with one insurance policy, one energy providers etc. etc. It was also decided, following the removal of the false ceiling in the MR which revealed severe problems with the roof, that the best thing would be to demolish the MR and rebuild, on the footprint, a single storey, connecting building that would have the kitchen, storage and toilets in. Last autumn the Diocese gave their consent to the transfer of the building and in September an application was made to the Charity Commission to merge the Parish Room charity & Mission Room charity and transfer the assets. This has all been done with the help of Tim Cartmell, retired solicitor and trustee of the Joyce Wilkinson Trust. The Trust is keen to help us rebuild this community centre. Consultations are still ongoing with the Charity Commission.
