A brief summary of the Annual Parish Council meeting held on Monday 18th May at Rosley Hall.

The Chairman thanked everyone for giving their continued support and time to serve on the council. The parish council continues to support many local organisations which serve our parish, the Northern Fells Group, the Village Halls, Wigton baths, local newsletters and others. The main business throughout the year has concerned highways matters some of which have been resolved but others are still awaiting action.

Election of officers: Mr S Brockbank was re-elected as Chairman and Mr T Todd as Vice Chairman.

Ward changes: the final recommendations mean that Westward will be represented by two county councillors, Westward will be represented by the Caldbeck councillor and Rosley & Curthwaite areas by Thursby & Aikton.

Viberoptix: there was a discussion about the rights of landowners regarding the erection of poles to carry fibre on private land. **Westward Mission Room:** The Charity Commission have said they will grant an order to enable the two halls to merge provided they have written agreement from all parties involved. We are waiting to hear from the CDBF to discuss the legal fees they want which are nearly £5k. Please note this is just a brief summary of the meeting, the full minutes are available from the clerk and are published on the website.
