A summary of the meeting held on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2023 at Rosley Village Hall.

Please note this is just a brief summary of the meeting, the full minutes are available from the clerk. County Councillor Mike Johnson attended. A fire in January caused extensive damage at **Westward Halls**, the committee are awaiting an insurance assessment before any work can begin to restore the Halls. Please note that the **defibrillator at Westward Halls is currently not in use**, because of the fire there is no electric supply. **Highways** – potholes are a continuing problem. It is important to report **every** individual pothole, each report is given a job number and only those listed on the crew's worksheet are repaired. If you list one and then say there are numerous others on that stretch of road only the one reported will be repaired! **Donations** were made to the following organisations:- Rosley and Westward Halls, Rosley and Westward Churchyards for maintenance, Rosley Link and Westward Newsletter, for maintenance of the three defibrillators in the parish, Northern Fells Group, Wigton Baths, Great North Air Ambulance, Westward litter pickers and Solway Red Squirrel Group.
