A summary of the meeting held at Rosley Hall on Monday 19th February 2024. Councillor Mike Johnson attended.

Highways: there was a lengthy discussion about the shocking state of the roads throughout the parish particularly the amount of potholes. Chairman, S. Brockbank, had met with a representative from Highways and surveyed the worst areas affected. They discussed measures which could be taken to try and prevent flooding and standing water on the roads which would then help prevent potholes forming. A report has been passed on to the Highways Agency.

It is very important to keep reporting all potholes, please don't assume someone else has already reported it. If there are a lot potholes on a stretch of road, identify the area i.e from A - B so all are reported, only those reported are getting repaired. The more reports received the sooner action is likely to be taken so **please keep on reporting!** To report a problem go to www.cumberland.gov.uk/streets-roads-and-pavements, select 'report a problem' or phone 0300 303 2992.
