A brief summary of the meeting held on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> February at Rosley Hall. Councillor Mike Johnson reported that the drainage problem at Red Dial has been resolved, work has been done on the culverts on Brocklebank and on drainage on the Broadmoor road. Potholes on Brocklebank are due to be filled soon and the Broadmoor road still needs resurfacing. Councillors reported that there is a problem with roadside edges breaking down on the road from the Street roadends to Rosley and in Curthwaite the problem of water flowing over the road into the village at the junction to East Curthwaite has still not been looked at. **Parish litter pick:** the Parish Council are organising a litter pick to take place in the spring.
