A summary of the meeting held at Rosley Hall on Monday 18th February.

A new clerk has been appointed and will commence duties at the next meeting in May. If you have any queries or would like any issues raised at that meeting please contact the current clerk – details above. The Chairman thanked Mrs Clark for all the help, support and advice she had given to the Council during her time as clerk.

Speed limit at Top Rosley - Rory Stewart MP has spoken to the Traffic Manager who reported the following:- the local CRASH group considered the request to reduce the speed limit in the summer. The current speed limit of vehicles was surveyed which showed that the existing speed limit was considered the most appropriate. The collision data was analysed and it was agreed at the CRASH meeting that a reduction of the speed limit would not be pursued but the site remains on police regular patrols. Enforcement of the existing speed limit will continue. **A Public Defibrillator** is to be installed in the old phone box at Curthwaite. The council donated £300 towards the cost and agreed to make a contribution towards the annual maintenance fee. The **Noticeboards** at Curthwaite and Rosley have been refurbished, the work was done by NFG Men in Sheds. **Footway Lighting** – Allerdale Borough Council is currently carrying out surveys, which should be completed by June 2019, in preparation for the transfer of costs to Parish Councils. Various problems relating to **Highways** throughout the parish were raised which the clerk will pass on to the relevant agencies.

If you know of any **road signs** which need cleaning or maintenance please notify the clerk or any parish councillor.

The maintenance of the **parish wood** is to be discussed at the next meeting.

Parish/Town and Borough Council Elections are to be held on Thursday 2nd May.

If you are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor please contact the clerk for nomination papers.

The next Parish Council Meeting is the Annual General Meeting on Monday 20th May at 7.30pm in Westward Halls. This will be preceded by the Annual Parish Meeting at 7pm.
