During Dementia Action Week NFG will be hosting an Anticipatory Grief session delivered by Karen Dutton (RGN & Dementia Champion) at Caldbeck Parish Hall for all those living with dementia, their carers' and families. Grief is a natural response to loss usually associated with the death of a loved one, but other losses can cause intense grief including loss of identity or loss of a perceived future. "Grief is the experience of knowing that change is coming and starting to experience bereavement in the face of that" For those at the early stages of living with dementia this session would be beneficial.
