A summary of the meeting held at Westward Halls on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> August 2019. Allerdale Borough Councillor Mr Tony Annison attended. Mr Annison reported that in future the responsibility and cost of **street lighting** will be borne by the parish council. **Refuse collections** – he has been assured that these will return to normal in the next couple of weeks. Many problems regarding **Highways** issues were raised. The clerk is to arrange for a site meeting with a representative from the Highways department. They will visit the parish and be shown the problem areas and explain what action can be taken. When reporting highways issues online it is helpful if a photograph can be included to show the nature of the problem. **Rosley Play Area** – it was felt that an independent safety inspection should be organised. The clerk is to get an estimate of the cost. **Westward Halls** – many repairs and improvements have already been carried out and fundraising is ongoing. The council agreed to grant £750 towards further costs. **Rosley Parish Wood** – An estimate of £750 has been obtained for renewal of the walkways in the wood. It was agreed to go ahead with the work. **Broadband** – Mr Annison is to look in to the situation regarding the poor broadband provision in the parish and this will be discussed at the next meeting. **The next Parish Council Meeting is on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> November at 7.30pm in Rosley Hall.** Members of the public are welcome at all meetings. If you would like any issues raised at this meeting please contact the clerk at least two weeks beforehand so that items can be included on the agenda. Please note this is just a brief summary of the meeting, the full minutes are available from the clerk.
