Cumberland Councillor Mike Johnston sent his apologies. The clerk is to contact him asking when broadband connections are likely to improve particularly in areas where there is already fibre nearby. **Highways:** Matthew Bish, Highway Network Officer for Cumberland Council met with some members of the parish council a while ago to discuss various highways matters within the parish. While some issues have been dealt with there are still many outstanding. Mr Bish did explain that unfortunately because of budget restraints and other priorities some issues may take a while to resolve. Some of the issues still outstanding are the flooding at Red Dial the 50mph sign at Red Dial which is still not working and the many potholes within the parish. He did stress that please could you report all highways problems, don't presume someone else has already reported it.

Would you enjoy driving for the Northern Fells Minibus Service? Have you time to volunteer to drive on two or three (or more!) half days most months? You do not need special training to drive as it is only an eight seater, so classed as a People Carrier, rather than a Minibus. You can drive it on your normal driving licence, Category B.

If you are interested, we will organise a DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) check for you and ask for two references. Once they are done and approved, we will organise a training session covering how the service works, its records, and familiarisation with driving the minibus and operating the wheelchair winch and fixings.
