A summary of the meeting held on Monday 19th August at Rosley Hall.

Highways: earlier in the year Chairman S Brockbank met with a representative from Highways to discuss what measures could be taken to try and prevent flooding and standing water on the roads which would then help prevent potholes forming. A report was to be sent to the Highways Agency. Very little has been done to date and Mr Brockbank is to follow up the issue.

It is very important to keep reporting all potholes, please don't assume someone else has already reported it. If there are a lot of potholes on a stretch of road, identify the area i.e from A - B so all are reported, only those reported are getting repaired. The more reports received the sooner action is likely to be taken so **please keep on reporting!** To report a problem go to www.cumberland.gov.uk/streets-roads-and-pavements, select 'report a problem' or phone 0300 303 2992.

A request from Rosley Church to increase the Parish Council donation towards grass cutting in the churchyard was considered. There has been a considerable increase in maintenance costs since the graveyard has been extended. It was agreed to support the request and the amount will be decided at the next meeting when the budget for next year is set.
